


Location of beneficiaries




Types of beneficiaries



Allocation of EU resources







PARTNERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- MINIMUM 2 from 2 different IPA Partner States.

THE PARTNERSHIP CAN INCLUDE A MAX OF 2 PARTNERS FROM THE SAME PARTNER STATE

MAXIMUM ELIGIBLE PARTNERSHIP: 16 PARTNERS

Potential beneficiaries – regardless whether they apply for the role of Lead or Project Partners – **cannot be involved in more than one project proposal per call/Priority Axis.**
